The Outdoor Ice Oval Society of Prince George has provided inexpensive outdoor ice skating for many years. The oval is maintained and operated by a group of dedicated volunteers, with support from the City of Prince George. However, with its natural ice surface, the oval is subject to short seasons and mid-season closures due to warm winter weather.

The outdoor ice oval has had significant improvements in facilities with the addition of the Construction Association Outdoor Ice Oval Centre (equipment building), and the Canfor House, (heated change facility) which were legacies of the 2015 Canada Winter Games. Oval Society volunteers have spent countless hours finishing and improving these facilities which have greatly contributed to the quality of ice and the skater experience.
